Impact of School PE funding 2017/2018

With this funding we aim to improve the provision of PE and sport in our school. In addition, each term ALL children have had the opportunity to participate in whole school sporting competitions. As a result, 100% of pupils took part in competitions in school. We are active members of the local Bournemouth schools cluster for sport, with 142 children (30%) taking part in local competitions. Children have also been participating in friendly matches with other junior and primary schools in the local area. This year we have also joined the Sports Youth Trust to enhance our school's knowledge.

We are very proud to have been awarded the Bronze School Games Mark this year and we have 20 school sports ambassadors working at Bronze level as part of the Primary Leadership Programme.

At King's Park Academy, we have always promoted the importance of sport in our school. We talent spot for children exhibiting exceptional sporting abilities to allow us to nurture and offers opportunities to enhance these skills within the wider community. We believe that sports enhance the lives of our children by teaching them to be active and healthy and live a healthy lifestyle. Sports also teach children morals when following rules and developing sportsmanship. The social aspect of school and learning is also met through sport in team games. Sporting excellence and participation has always been a very strong focus in our school.

New Equipment

We ensured that the school has a variety of equipment to teach a range of skills and sports. New equipment has been purchased to encourage children to participate in physical activity. Below is a list of equipment that has been purchased in order to deliver PE lessons effectively and for the children to experience new sports. This includes:

Curriculum Enrichment

King's Park Academy are proud to offer our children a wide range of extra-curricular activities which are led by our Curriculum Enrichment Coordinator. The vast majority of our clubs are run free of charge and include not only sports clubs designed to engage children further with team games but also clubs that celebrate the creative arts and those which further a love of learning. Currently the extra-curricular clubs on offer to all pupils, free of charge, are: Netball, Athletics, Dance, Football, Gardening, Cookery, Drama, Change for Life, Singing and an Art club. As well as small charge extra-curricular activities which are: Gymnastics, Dodgeball and Karate.

We were very excited this year to be able to subsidize sailing lessons for children in Years 4 and 5. As a result, we had 32 children achieve their RYA Level 1 sailing and 2 children continue on to achieve their RYA Level 2 sailing accreditation. This year we have 52 children interested in learning sailing with 80% of the children wanting to continue from last year to progress through the levels. Also, 10 children were invited by Rockley Park to join them for the day at the Southampton Boat Show this September. Selected children took part in a Sailing Regatta during the summer term and King's Park achieved a gold, silver and bronze medal.

We also had one child qualify to represent Bournemouth in the Dorset County Athletics Championship in 150m event. He finished 4th in the county.

In addition, King's Park Academy have built strong links with local community clubs and organizations such as AFC Bournemouth Community Team, Avonbourne Gymnastics, Foundation Sports, Bournemouth Council, and Sainsbury's. Over the academic year King's Park Academy run additional clubs on the school grounds allowing our children the chance to experience and enjoy a wider range of sports and community based activities. This is inspiring the children with the opportunity to succeed and excel in competitive sport and allowing them to participate in wider community projects.
