



Impact of School PE funding 2019/2020

With this funding we aim to improve the provision of PE and sport in our school. In addition, each term ALL children have had the opportunity to participate in whole school sporting competitions. As a result, 100% of pupils took part in competitions in school. We are active members of the local Bournemouth schools cluster for sport, with 57 children taking part in local competitions. Children have also been participating in friendly matches with other junior and primary schools in the local area. This year we have also joined the Sports Youth Trust to enhance our school's knowledge.

We are very proud to have maintained the Bronze School Games Mark this year and we have 20 school sports ambassadors working at Bronze level as part of the Primary Leadership Programme.

At King's Park Academy, we have always promoted the importance of sport in our school. We talent spot for children exhibiting exceptional sporting abilities to allow us to nurture and offers opportunities to enhance these skills within the wider community. We believe that sports enhance the lives of our children by teaching them to be active and healthy and live a healthy lifestyle. Sports also teach children morals when following rules and developing sportsmanship. The social aspect of school and learning is also met through sport in team games. Sporting excellence and participation has always been a very strong focus in our school.

The Sports Premium Funding has allowed us to improve the quality of our PE provision. The school received **£21,450** and we have spent that on ensuring high quality PE and health education across our school. Below is a summary of how we have spent the Sport Premium Funds and how the Sports Premium is having an impact on the quality, participation, skill development and enjoyment of PE at King's Park Academy.

£15,125– Sports provision management
£2,575– Sports equipment/Curriculum PE coaching/Club funding
£3,750 - Swimming

Curriculum Enrichment

King's Park Academy are proud to offer our children a wide range of extra-curricular activities which are led by our Curriculum Enrichment Coordinator Mrs R. Bellingham. The vast majority of our clubs are run free of charge and include not only sports clubs designed to engage children further with team games but also clubs that celebrate the creative arts and those which further a love of learning. Currently the extra-curricular clubs on offer to all pupils, free of charge, are: Netball, Football, Rhythm and Strings, Athletics, Gardening, Drama, Dance, Change for Life, Mindfulness, Forest Schools, Singing, Spanish and an Art club. As well as small charge extra-curricular activities which are: Gymnastics, Dodgeball and Karate.

We had planned to subsidize sailing lessons for children in Years 4 and 5 but due to the national lockdown this was put on hold for next academic year.

In addition, King's Park Academy have built strong links with local community clubs and organizations such as AFC Bournemouth Community Team, Avonbourne Gymnastics, Bournemouth Council, and Sainsbury's. Over the academic year King's Park Academy run additional clubs on the school grounds allowing our children the chance to experience and enjoy a wider range of sports and community based activities. This is inspiring the children with the opportunity to succeed and excel in competitive sport and allowing them to participate in wider community projects.
