Yesterday, you should have all received by email the next two week's home learning for your child's year group. This can also be found on our school website www.kingspark-academy.co.uk

If your child is in Reception, then you will access all home learning through your tapestry account. If you have mislaid your log in details, then please email the front office for a new link at kpa@kingspark-academy.co.uk.

All other year groups will access their home learning through Purple Mash. Your child will receive a daily email with a timetable of lessons that needs to be followed. We will be using Oak Academy for the majority of the lessons, as well as videoed lessons from your child's teacher. You will also receive a phone call twice a week from your child's teacher to see how you are getting on with your learning and to answer any questions that you or your child may have. Please ensure that you answer a call from a withheld number as it may be us. So that your child receives feedback on their work, they can take a photo of their learning and email it to their teacher through their Purple Mash email.

Remember to access emails through Purple Mash, you need to type 2email into the search bar.

We are aware that the children have missed so much of their education already and currently we are unsure of how long this lockdown will last, therefore it is imperative that your child completes the work that is set. Daily reading and learning times tables are also a must as part of your child's daily routine.

I would like to thank you all for your support during this time. I am aware that home learning is not the easiest and being secluded from family and friends is difficult at this time, but we really appreciate your dedication to your child's education.
