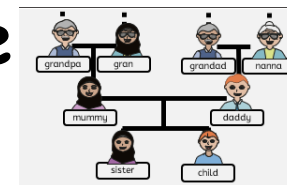




Our topics for Autumn Term in Year 1 are 'here I am' and 'My family History'

Zones of Regulation



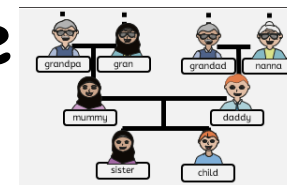
The Zones of Regulation are used at KPA to encourage children to self-regulate their emotions so that they are happy at school and can complete their best learning.
