School Meal Payments

Just a reminder that if your child is moving into KS2 (Year 3 upwards) they will no longer be eligible for universal free school meals from September 2018. If you wish them to continue to have hot school meals, these cost £11.50 per week and payment must be made before 4pm on Tuesdays for the following week, using the online payment system.

School milk for children eligible for Free School Meals

As you may be aware, children who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) are also able to have free milk to drink in school daily. If your child would like to have milk, you will first need to register them with Cool Milk and then inform the school office, who will arrange for the school to cover the cost.
