Consultation of Proposed Changes to Timings of the School Day

I am writing to consult with you about a possible change to the timing of the school day with effect from 1 September 2019.

It is our aim to make the school day more efficient for all our pupils and staff to ensure teaching and learning is always as effective as possible whilst enjoying the significant number of additional activities.

THE PROPOSAL

Start of School Day	Would remain the same
Morning Timetable – Lessons 1 and 2	Would remain the same
Lunchtimes	Would remain the same
Afternoon Timetable – Lesson 3	Would change to: KS1 – 13.05 – 15.10 KS2 – 13.35 – 15.10
End of School Day	School would finish at 15.10

All extra-curricular activities will continue and possibly expand with the proposed earlier finish.

NEXT STAGE OF THE CONSULTATION

We are consulting with staff and parents regarding these proposals and we would welcome parents' views by email to kpa@kingspark-academy.co.uk (please reference your email 'CONSULTATION RESPONSE') by the consultation closing date of **Monday, 8 July 2019**.

Following the completion of the consultation, the final decision will be made by the Academy Advisory Committee and I will communicate this directly to you.

If the proposal is approved by the Academy Advisory Committee we expect to implement these proposals for the start of the 2019-2020 academic year on 1 September 2019.

I very much value your views and will consider carefully any comments that are received.
