On your first day back, we will go through all of the new rules and expectations that are in place to keep everyone as safe as possible. Mrs Dean will let you know which group you are in but the table below should answer some of your questions.

<b>Which days will I be in school?</b>	Group A - Monday to Friday, weeks beginning 22/6 and 6/7 Group B - Monday to Friday, weeks beginning 29/6 and 13/7		
<b>Why aren't I in school every week?</b>	To keep everyone as safe as we can, we can only have up to 15 children in each group. Unfortunately, we do not have enough teachers or rooms to have everyone in school at the same time.		
<b>What will I do when I am not at school?</b>	Ms Ebdon will still be setting and marking 2dos on Purple Mash, and your teacher will also set you some tasks to complete while you're not at school.		
<b>Which classroom am I in?</b>	5JB	4AE	5SR
<b>Which adults am I with?</b>	Miss Jelley	Miss Mahony	Mrs Palmer and Mrs White
<b>What time do I start school?</b>	9:15 - 9:25	9:35 - 9:45	9:25 - 9:35
<b>What if I am late to school?</b>	If you do not arrive within your ten- minute slot, you will be sent home as we are not able to accept any late pupils.		
<b>What time is lunch?</b>	12:15 - 13:15		
<b>What time do I finish school?</b>	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday-</b> 14:30 - 14:40 <b>Wednesday - 13:15</b>	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday -</b> 14:50 - 15:00 <b>Wednesday - 13:35</b>	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday-</b> 14:40 - 14:50 <b>Wednesday - 13:25</b>
<b>What if I am a key worker?</b>	Come to school each day, at the hall gate as usual between 8:40 and 9:00 and get picked up at 15:10. You will have a week with your year 6 teacher and a week with Mrs Romain. Then repeat.		
<b>Can I walk home by myself?</b>	Yes, if your parents email <a href="mailto:kpa@kingspark-academy.co.uk">kpa@kingspark-academy.co.uk</a> to give permission for you to. If we do not receive this, we will not be able to let you leave alone.		
<b>What should I wear?</b>	Your normal school uniform without a tie, a coat if it's cold and sun cream if it's hot!		
<b>What do I need to bring to school?</b>	A <u>named</u> water bottle and a packed lunch (unless you usually get a free school meal). There is nowhere to store bikes or scooters so please do not bring these.		
<b>Can my child bring their mobile to school?</b>	Your child will only need to bring their mobile to school if they walk home on their own. The phone will need to be taken to their bubble where the class teacher will have a place for them to go. We will not take any responsibility for the loss or damage of mobile phones.
