### **Year 6 trip to the Milestones Museum- Friday 7th June 2024**

As part of our topic for the Summer term called 'Britain at War' we are planning to take the children to the Milestones Museum in Basingstoke. The museum is an immersive living history museum providing lots of hands-on experience for the children. In addition to exploring the museum itself, we have booked two workshops for the children to take part in, led by the experts on site, consolidating their knowledge of World War II.

The visit will take place on Friday 7th June 2024.

The cost of the trip, including coach transfer, museum entry and workshops, will be £25 which can be paid for via your account on [www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com) using a credit or debit card. Payments should be made **by Friday 31st May**. Please do not send cash into school. If you anticipate that you may have problems with the payment, please speak to your child's class teacher or Mrs Heathman as soon as possible. Payment will automatically assume that you are giving parental consent for your child to attend this trip.

On the day, children will require a packed lunch. However, if your child has school dinners, one will be provided for them. They will also need to ensure they have a water bottle and piece of fruit for a snack. They will need to be smartly dressed in their school uniform and have a coat for walking outside. Suitable school footwear must be worn as the museum features cobbled streets.

Children will be travelling via coach to and from Basingstoke. **The coach will be departing school at 8.30am so children MUST be in school by this time.** Coaches will return the children to school in time for the end of the school day.
