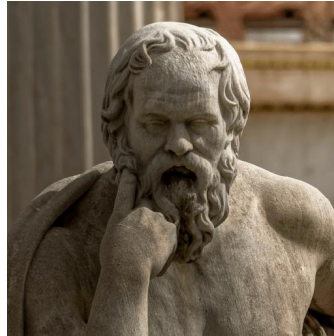


# Our topic for the Summer Term in Year 5 is 'Groundbreaking Greeks'

## In Maths we will be developing our understanding of:

- Position and movement
- Measuring – Length
- Measuring – Mass
- Measuring - Time



## In English we will be:

- Writing a traditional story
- Writing a balanced argument
- Writing an Ode
- Learning to use more complex punctuation
- Extending our understanding of vocabulary
- Learning more complex grammar rules

## In History we will be learning about:

- Significant periods of Greek history
- Different Greek civilizations
- Family life and social class
- Significant people
- Lasting legacies including democracy, philosophy and maths, the Olympic Games and Arts and culture.

This project teaches children about developments and changes over six periods of ancient Greek history, focusing on the city state of Athens in the Classical age, and exploring the lasting legacy of ancient Greece.

## In PE the children will be:

- Developing skills in fitness and athletics (Summer 1)
- Developing skills in gymnastics and rounders (Summer 2)
